**Student Voices Against Poverty**

*Student Voices Against Poverty* (SVAP) is an initiative of the UN Millennium Campaign to eradicate poverty and hunger. The program enables students to be researchers and activists in anti-poverty efforts in their community. SVAP educates teachers about global poverty and provides them with some 20 lesson plans to help them share this knowledge with their students in order that they both address the root causes of poverty and inequality.

Lessons employ a variety of teaching approach and are aligned to national standards in civics, math, science, economics, world history, fine arts and health.
