MEETING WILL CONSIDER CIVIC CLUB FEDERATION

C. F. COFFIN INVITED TO MAKE
AN ADDRESS.

CONFERENCE FEBRUARY 2

An organization meeting, at which steps will be taken for the drafting of a constitution and bylaws for a federation of civic associations of Indianapolis, will be held at the Chamber of Commerce Thursday, February 2, at 7:30 p. m., E. O. Snetten, temporary chairman of the federation, announced today.

At present about twenty civic associations are in existence in the city, Mr. Snetten said. About seventeen of these have announced their intention to be members of the federation. An effort will be made to bring all the associations into the federation. Several preliminary meetings have been held.

"We feel that if we can bring about the federation of all the civic associations in the city," Mr. Snetten said, "we would have an organization that would represent practically the entire city. Our object would be to improve conditions in the entire city through the federation, permitting local federations to take care of their individual problems, but with assistance from the federation."

A. Leroy Forttous is chairman of the committee which is arranging for the meeting at the Chamber of Commerce. He has asked Charles F. Coffin, president of the Chamber of Commerce, to speak.
