On June 21, 2019 the Indianapolis Public School (IPS) selected Teach for America alum and interim superintendent Alessia Johnson to be the district's leader. She was preceded by Dr. Lewis Ferebee, a Broad Academy fellow who helped close and/or privatize Indy's public schools and sell off the assets of IPS to the businesses, community, who is now the superintendent of D.C. schools. Parent Power predicts under the Johnson regime, IPS will mimic New Orleans and become a business-model privatized school district (IPS Inc.) using a portfolio model where IPS will not be a school system, but a system of schools.

The response of Parent Power, Indy's Parents Across America affiliate, is to spend less time continuing our critique of Supt.
