**MINISTER DECLARES  
REAL U. S. CITIZEN  
MUST BE CHRISTIAN**

**Pastor of Edinburg (Ind.)  
Church Addresses Men  
Builders, Inc.**

A man, to be a real American, must be a Christian, and steps should be taken to make all elements of this country realize that real Americans must not stoop to un-Christian levels and influences, the Rev. H. R. Pearcy, pastor of the Christian Church at Edinburg, said yesterday morning in an address on "Citizenship" at the meeting of the Christian Men Builders, Inc., at the Third Christian Church, Seventeenth street and Broadway.

The meeting, which was in charge of the fourteen candidates for the "Blue Vase degree" of the Go-Getter Club, broke attendance records with 475 young men present at the "surprise session." The original candidates for the degree were Raymond E. Freeman, Leonard Carlin, Kent Dorman, F. W. Fackler, Elmer Faulkner, Fred E. Horner, M. V. McKeighan, J. R. Merryman, Harry H. Ochltree, E. C. Sappenfield, Glen H. Sells, Jess W. Thompson, John M. Trozell and Howard D. Wright.

"We have too many of the aliens of this country who are sending their earnings back home instead of investing that money in the land where they made it," said the Rev. Mr. Pearcy.

"There are too many Jews in this country who do not know the meaning of patriotism. There are too many Jews who will do anything in this country to better themselves financially. Patriotism to them is a matter of dollars and cents. There are Jews who have become Christians simply to benefit themselves financially. The Jews are spoken of as the people without a country.
